SeaTrack is our web-based customer portal which offers a seamless flow of information across the customer's life cycle of a shipment from manufacturer through to final delivery. Using this system means that our customers can readily obtain the information required to monitor the progress of their cargo through various key milestones and checkpoints.

We can automate reporting on supplier performance including cargo ready dates and document processing. The system is fully integrated with Carriers and Terminals for real-time updates on your cargo. SeaTrack is completely customisable to unique business requirements and the system can monitor the supply chain performance, automate notifications on important steps, or provide customer alerts on exceptions.

Our system has the capabilities for full EDI integration if required and all commercial documents pertaining to individual shipments are stored online for five years.



## Off-shore Consolidations

Our offices in China & South East Asia have direct access to both bonded and non-bonded warehouses across all major cities.

Our system can manage various purchase suppliers simultaneously to ensure consolidation fulfillment is executed efficiently.
