In Transit Cold Treatment

The SEAWAY Group has the capability of applying state of the art force air cooling 600 pallets (20 x 40') through a cooling system specifically designed with the In Transit Cold Treatment (ITCT) protocols in mind. This forms a critical part of our ITCT loading service along with experience authorised officers, and loading staff who follow rigid guidelines to ensure protocols and work plan criteria are met each and every time.

Options via road and rail are available ex Mildura along with 24/7 receipt, loading and lodgment of containers via our own in house wharf cartage division located in Altona. Pre-shipment inspection, re-palletising, consolidation and labeling are available for commodities.
